FARM FACTS:

- Mixed livestock, 100Ha / 250 acres
- There are around 200 ewes, Simmental beef cows, with Shorthorn Bulls called Ned & Bruce
- Farmed by the Knight family for 65+ years.
- Parts of the farm go back to medieval times and we find Neolithic flint tools in the fields.
- Mob grazing regenerative agriculture, moving towards organic standards
- Biodiversity encouraged through environmental stewardship & part of Farm Cluster group with Chalk Cherries and Chairs AONB project.
- Wildlife includes Barn Owls, Skylarks, Yellowhammers, Harvest Mice, Pyramidal Orchids, Glow Worms, Grass Snake etc.
- You can buy small bale hay, straw & fresh eggs!

- The farm is the base for Countryways CIC, providing opportunities for those with learning difficulties, physical & mental health challenges.
- Our donkeys, goats, hens, rabbits & guinea pigs help specifically with Care Farming.
